PINEAPPLE, anyone? After you cut pineapple tops from the fruit, dry for a few days, then plant with the base just covered in a mixture of equal parts soil, sand, and peat moss. Keep this just barely moist for several weeks - until you are sure the plant has formed roots. Then you can water a little more, but still not much. It is better to treat this plant like any other bromeliad. Keep the rosette of leaves filled with water; pay little attention to the soil it is growing in. Apply bi-weekly feedings of houseplant fertilizer. If all goes well, you can expect fruit in from 24 to 36 months after rooting the top. Grow in a sunny location. It likes to be spotted on a patio, porch, or steps in summer.

WAXED ORCHIDS: If flowers such as gardenias, camellias, fuchsias, orange blossoms, or magnolias can be waxed and floated on water ... can an orchid blossom? If you want to try...read on...select flowers that are fresh and free from bruises that may turn dark after the flower is waxed. Rinse flowers in cold water and drain on paper toweling in the refrigerator until ready to use, or merely wipe dust from leaves and dip the flowers as soon as wax is at the right temperature. Wax that is too hot burns the flowers and they turn brown, especially white blooms.

Melt completely 2 to 3 pounds of paraffin in the top of a double boiler over hot water. Allow wax to cool until lukewarm to your touch, about 110° to 120°. Before dipping a flower, use a spoon to skim off the scum of solidifying wax; save to remelt. Holding onto the stem, dip the flower into the wax with a steady downward motion, swish it around once or twice and lift out of wax. Quickly but gently shake the flower to remove excess wax and loosen the petals: then turn right side up. Hold it in your hand for a few seconds, or until wax sets slightly and then immerse in cool water. Set on foil-covered baking sheets and place in freezer or refrigerator just long enough to firm the wax, but not to freeze the bloom. Store in refrigerator.

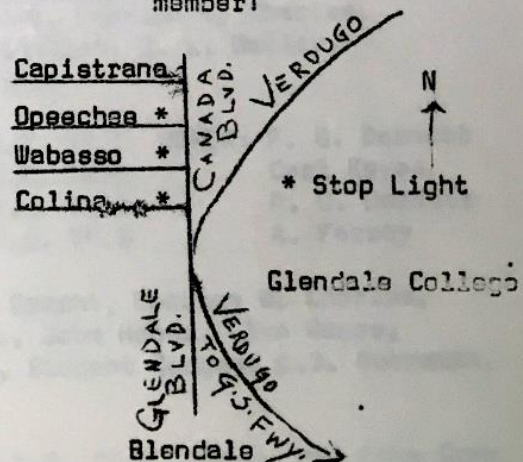

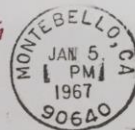
