



As a novice orchid grower I have often been curious about the awards given to plants and the jargon used really intrigued me. When first I heard about ribbon awards, that seemed logical, but, have you ever heard someone talking about the A.M. when you knew it was the P.M.... or being upset because it was just a B.M.? Well, about that time, I decided that it was time to learn more.

Ribbon Awards may be given out at any society solely on the beauty of the bloom, as selected by the judges. They are not necessarily qualified Judges, however. And this is not a recognized national rating.

American Orchid Society Awards are the nationally recognized Awards and must be judged by certified Judges, are given an awards number, are listed in the American Orchid Society Bulletin.

The South Coast Orchid Society is ONE of only Two Societies in the Los Angeles-Orange Counties area where this judging is available.

Woody Wilson, Judging Chairman for SoCo Society, has offered to answer any questions we may have. However, here are some that have already been frequently been asked.

Q. Who may have the plants judged?

- A. Anyone who is interested and who owns the plant.
- Q. Where else are the plants judged?
- A. At Regional, sub-regional meetings and shows at times listed in the American Orchid Society Bulletin.
- Q. What does it cost to have a plant judged?
- A. There is no cost except that when a plant is awarded there is a fee of \$20.00 for the Certificate of Award. This charge is made by the American Orchid Society.
- Q. What are the awards and scores? 90 - 100 points A. First Class Certificate (F.C.C.) Award of Merit(A.M.) 80 - 89 Highly Commended Certificate(H.C.C.) 75 - 79 80 or more points Botanical Merit Cultural Certificate 80 or more points
- Q. How are plant scores determined?
- A. Scores are determined against a theoretical maximum of 100 Points based upon knowledge of the plant and comparison to others of the same breeding.
- Q. What time does judging begin?
- A. Plants to be judges must be in the judging room at 7:00 p.m.

Everyone is ursed to bring in plants for judging. If the plant does not win an award the Chairman of Judging will arrange for an explanation of what is needed to bring it up to award quality upon request.
