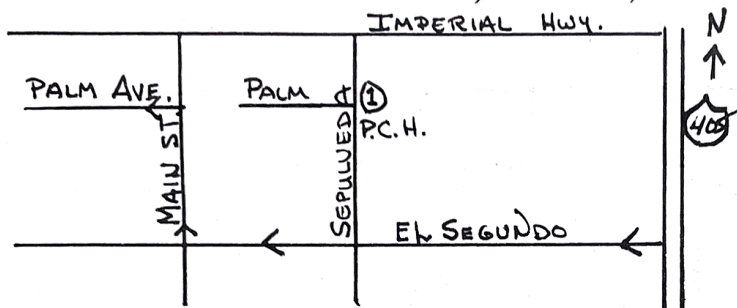


# NOVICE NEWS

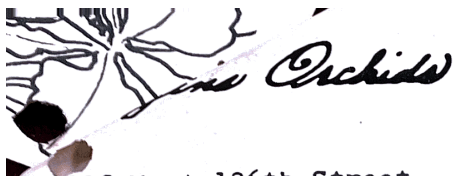

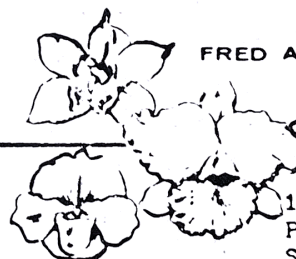
