



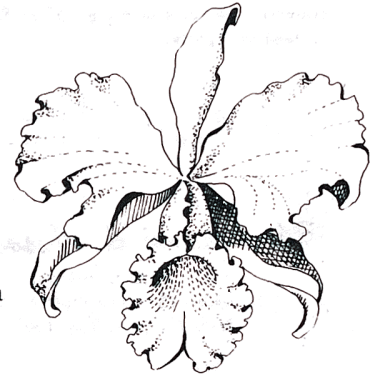

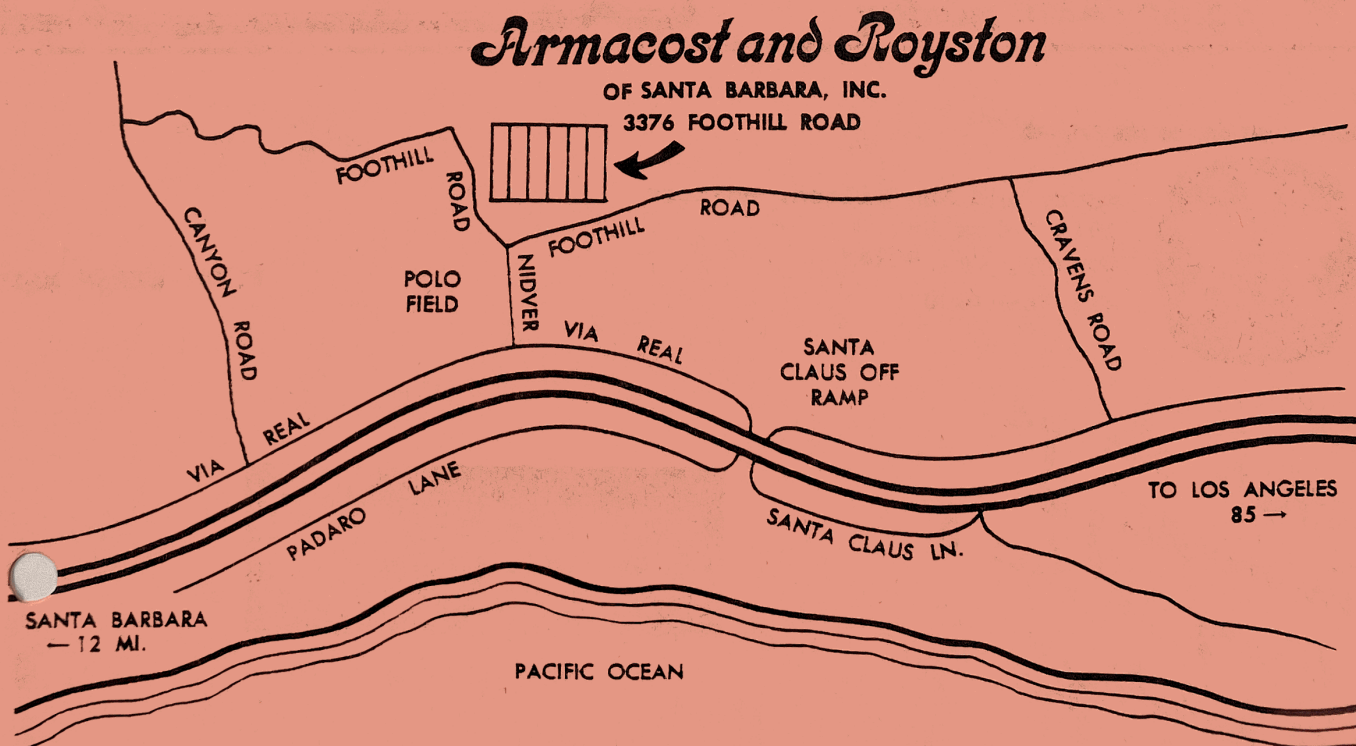
The June 7th meeting will be very special because it will be our semi-annual "certificate meeting" and we are going to journey to Armacost & Royston in Santa Barbara for this event.
