## **Growing, Potting and Mounting Demonstrations**

**Program Starts at 7:00 p.m.**

**Monday, May 18, 2015**

Your SCOS presents a potting and mounting workshop consisting of demonstrations from our best growers (as evaluated by our monthly ribbon judging competition). This will include evaluation of member plants that need either repotting or reblooming.

The orchid family consists of over 30,000 species and hundreds of thousands of hybrids, each with their own unique requirements for best growth. Correctly choosing the time of year to resettle your orchid, whether to "pot on" or divide, what media is best for your growing location, whether to pot or mount, and what water, fertilizer, and care after repotting is needed can all affect just how well your plants will do. Come and explore these issues through demonstrations with several genres. Also bring in your problem plants for evaluation and advice on reblooming.

There will be a plant opportunity table provided by SCOS.
