Silver Medal for Meritorious Service to the Orchid World in 1955 at Western Orchid Conference in Long Beach. Serving as a judge in the Cymbidium Society of America, American Orchid Society, Orchid Society of So. California and Orchid Digest Corp. Was a delegate to the first World Orchid Congress where he was active in establishing the present system of judging and its score sheets. He is presently Editor of the Cymbidium News and a member of the Board of Directors of the Cymbidium Society of America, Inc.
