"MADAGASCAR AND THE NEARBY ISLANDS"

Awarding of 1961 Annual Trophies for Outstanding Flowers

Fortunate indeed are we - to present Dr. George C. Kennedy as our guest speaker for the 1962 Annual Banquet. Dr. Kennedy is presently Professor of Geochemistry at U.C.L.A., and has previously held positions with the U.S. Geological Survey, Naval Research Laboratories, and Harvard University, his Alma Mater, in addition to his capacity as consultant to various industrial companies and governmental agencies. In these capacities, travel has been a necessity, and probably no other man in Southern California has visited so many Orchid growing countries of the world. His avid interest in collecting orchid species around the world has led him to many interesting places, and interesting people, who in turn lead him on to new places. This brings us to the island of Madagascar - where well over a thousand species of orchids exist. Of these only some 600 have been described with an equal number still in the category of "new species" or undescribed. Dr. Kennedy will talk on his fascinating experiences on this island and will portray some of his "finds" with slides.

To complement our speakers subject, Jerry Worthen has again graciously consented to design and decorate the tables in her own inimitable manner, of which there is no peer. Her theme is "Orchids of Madagascar"

Last months program, presented by Herb and Rita Crothers, more than exceeded our expectations on the subject of Specimen Plants. The Crothers have obviously expended a great deal of time and energy in their research on this interesting field of plant propagation. The slides were all well selected and the presentation brought to light many interesting facets in the development of a Specimen plant.

PLANT PROCUREMENT

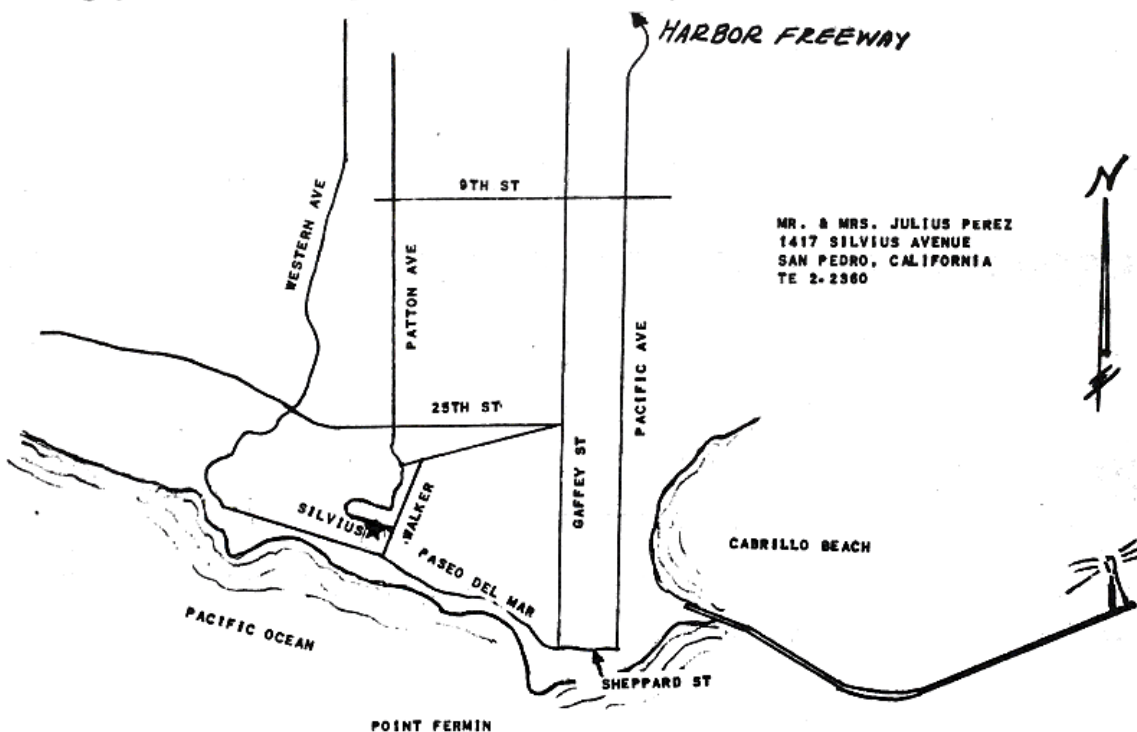

Good dark lavenders of good form and substance should result. Season fall to winter.

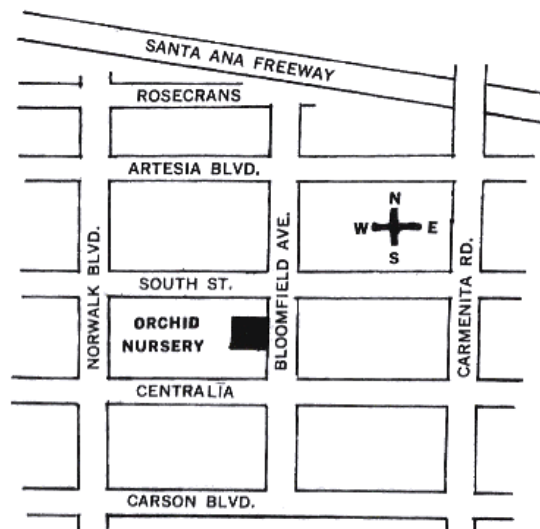

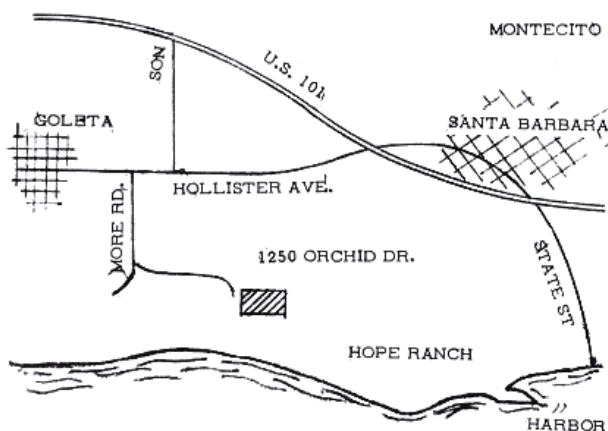

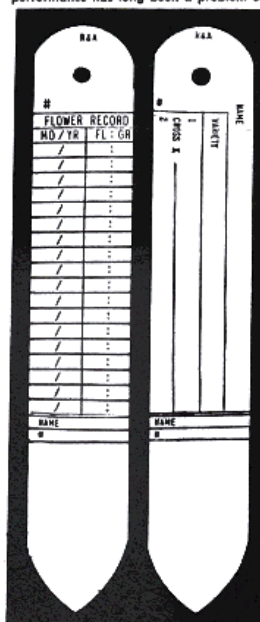
