"ORCHID GROWING AT DOS PUEBLOS"

Our speaker this month is well known to us all. Joe Hampton is one of our own members and it is indeed a pleasure to have him as our guest speaker.

Joe is very well known throughout the Orchid World. He is an American Orchid Society Judge, and Orchid Digest Corporation Judge, and has held many offices in many Societies. He is now Vice-President of the Dos Pueblos Orchid Company of Goleta. Because of his vast knowledge of the culture and hybridization of Orchids, this should prove to be a very outstanding and informative program.

Let's all turn out and give Joe a big welcome and show him how much we appreciate his taking time out to travel from Santa Barbara to speak to our group.

The speaker at the May meeting was Mr. Clarence I. Kado, Research Assistant in the Plant Pathology Department at the University of California at Berkeley. His subject, "Virus Diseases of Orchids" was of great interest. Utilizing the results of recent research, Mr. Kado gave a comprehensive report of the types of virus, symptoms of virus infection in orchids, and precautions and control methods which can be taken to prevent the spread of infection. Slides were shown which revealed Odontoglossum Ringspot Virus, Mosaic Virus, and other types of Virus on cymbidium leaves. Another group of slides showed effects of cymbidium Mosaic Virus and necrotic ringspot patterns on Cattleya leaves. Precautions suggested by Mr. Kado include: flame tools, control aphids, and isolate or eliminate infected plants. For more information on cattleya diseases and control measures, members may write to: Department of Pathology, University of California, Berkeley 4, California. We again thank Mr. Kado for this thorough report, the excellent slides and his patience in answering all our questions.

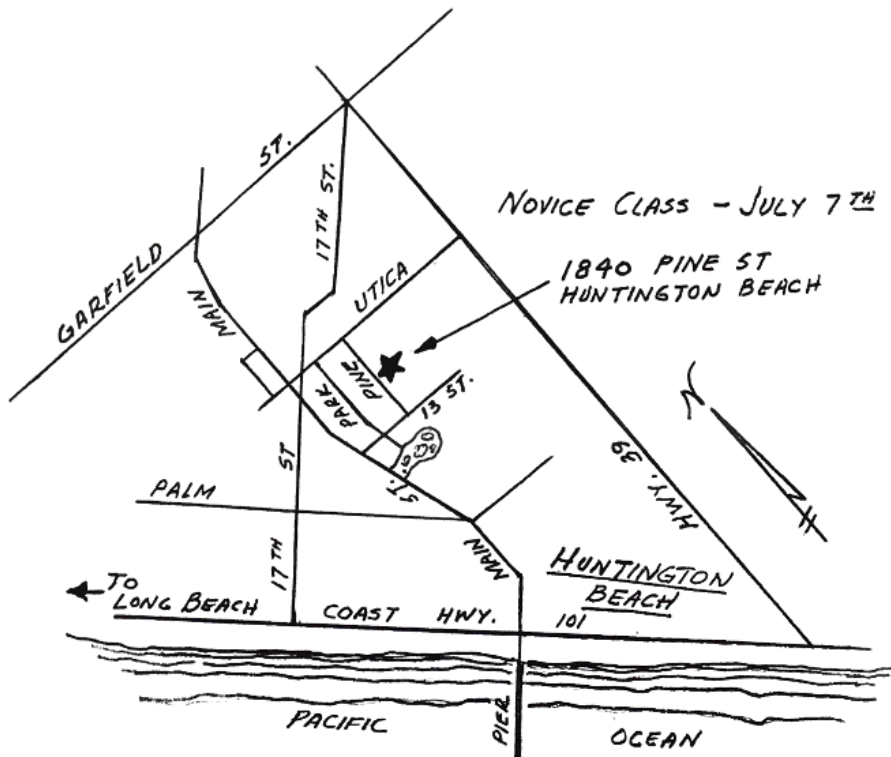
