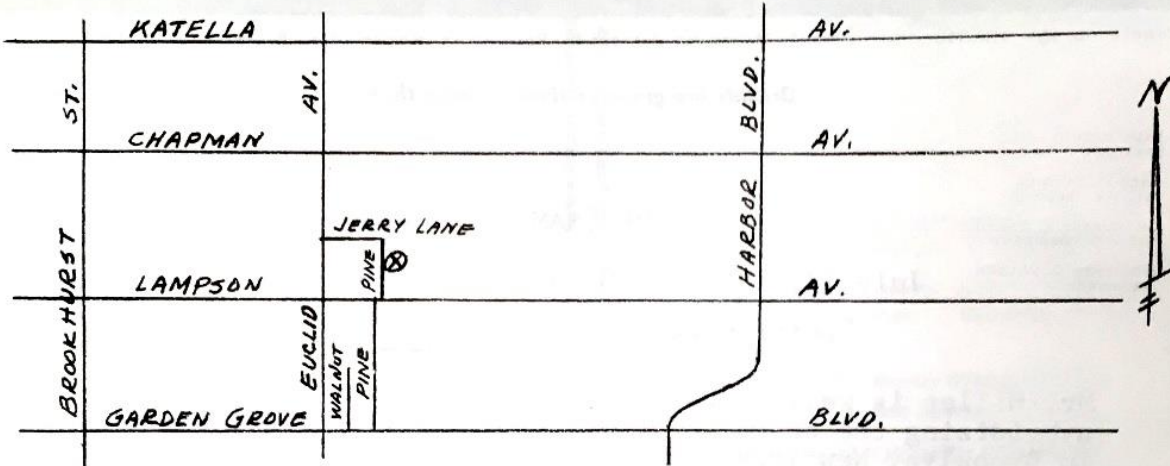
COFFEE BREAK
