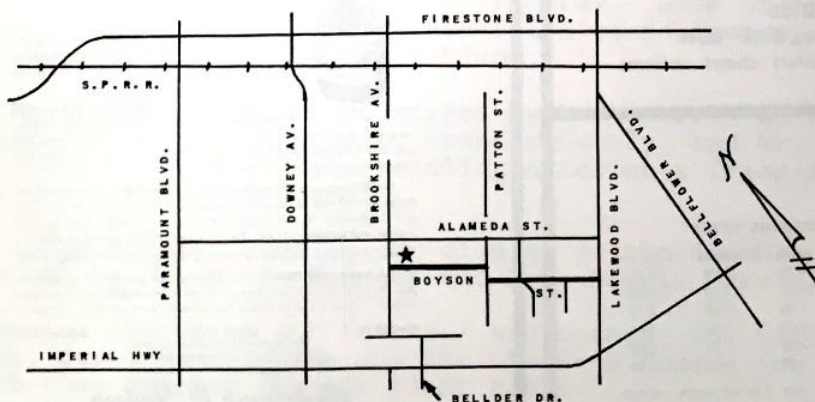


Instead of Harry Rappella our speaker
