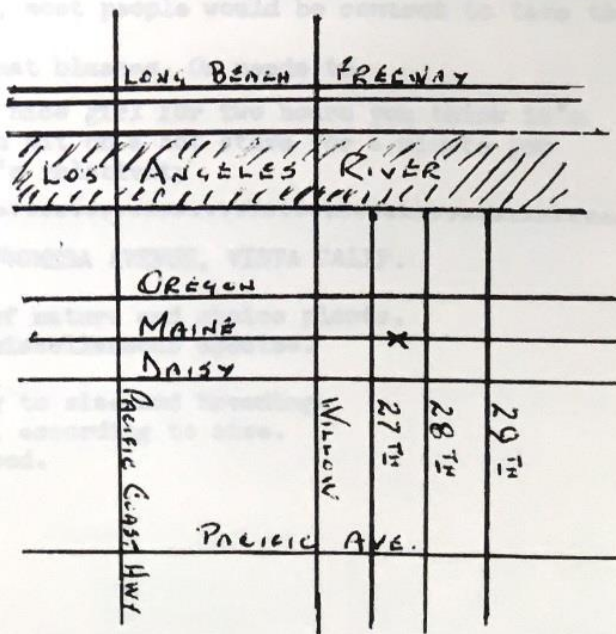

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SOUTH COAST ORCHIDS SOCIETY INC. TROPHIES.

1. Recipient must be a member in good standing of the South Coast Orchid Society at time award is granted. (i.e. Award granted in January-exhibitor joins the society in March. He is not eligible. Conversely- if exhibitor is a continuing member but did not pay his current dues until March he would be eligible.)
2. Plants competing for trophies must be properly designated on the Judging Entry Form, i. e. 1st blooming Cattleya seedling; American bred Cattleya.
3. The trophies have been divided into two Classes -Amateur and Open Class.
 - A. Open Class is open to all exhibitors
 - B. Amateur Class is open to Amateur growers only.Definition of Classes:
 1. Commercial Grower
 - a. Does engage in growing orchids commercially (this includes professional growers) and / or
 - b. Does conduct a commercial establishment for the sale of orchid plants and/ or flowers.
 2. An Amateur Grower is one who does not meet the qualifications which define a commercial Grower.
4. Plants to win a trophy must score a minimum of 75 points
