COLOR INFLUENCE IN CATTLEYAS (ART SHADES)

Come early and be sure of getting a seat, for this month we are privileged to have Mr. M. Miyamoto present a program on color influence in cattleyas together with slides and information on other genera which have been produced in Hawaii. As many of you undoubtedly know, Miya, as he is usually called, is one of Hawaii's most successful orchid hybridizers and growers. His major impact in the past few years has been in the creation of "Art Shade" Cattleyas, but he is also active in breeding Vandas, Dendrobiums, Phalaenopsis and Ascocendas. Mr. Miyamoto has been growing orchids for about 34 years, and is presently an A.O.S. Trustee. Certainly he is amongst the most successful and most highly respected Orchidists in Hawaii.

We believe this will be one of the most outstanding programs presented in Southern California in 1970.

Certainly everyone is invited to attend this meeting. In fact, don't miss the opportunity to hear a speaker from our newest addition to the United States, the Aloha State.
