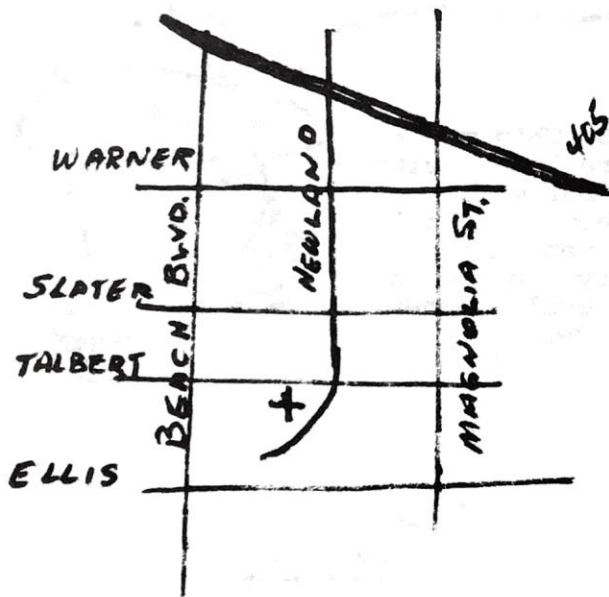


## NOVICE CLASS

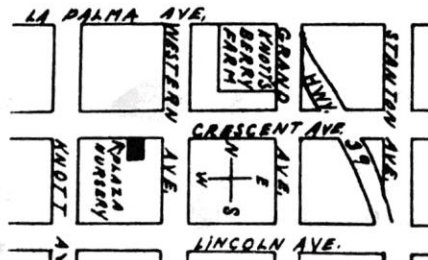

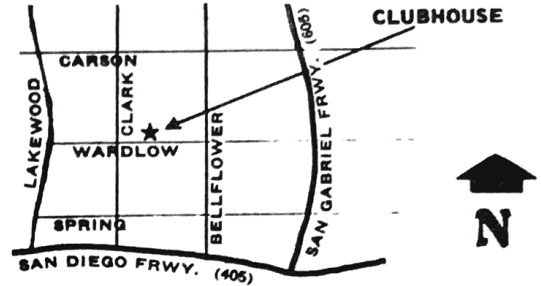
