- 4) PHALAENOPSIS
- 5) ASCOCENTRUM, VANDA & ALLIED VANDACEOUS GENERA
- 6) DENDROBIUMS
- 7) ODONTOGLOSSOMS, ONCIDIUMS, MILTONIAS AND ALLIED GENERA
- 8) ALL OTHER GENERA

POINTS WILL BE GIVEN AS FOLLOWS: FIRST PLACE, EACH CATEGORY - 5 POINTS SECOND PLACE, EACH CATAGORY - 3 POINTS THIRD PLACE, EACH CATAGORY - 1 POINT CULTURAL AWARD, EACH CATEGORY-5 POINTS

IF THE JUDGES DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO PLANT WORTHY OF A RIBBON IN ANY OF THE CATEGORIES, THEN NO AWARD WILL BE MADE FOR THAT CATEGORY.


