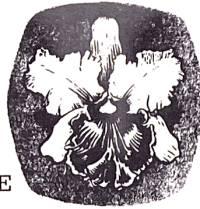

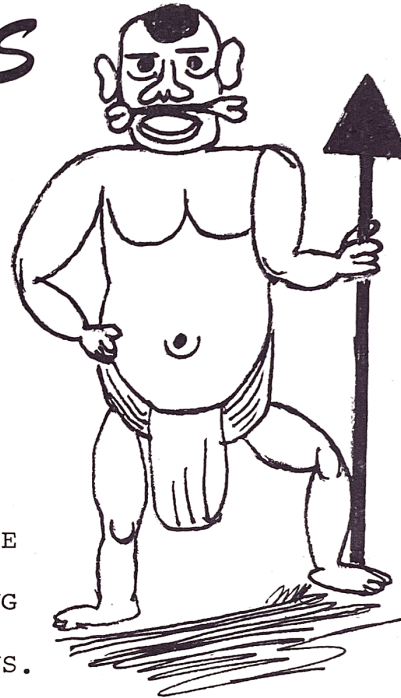

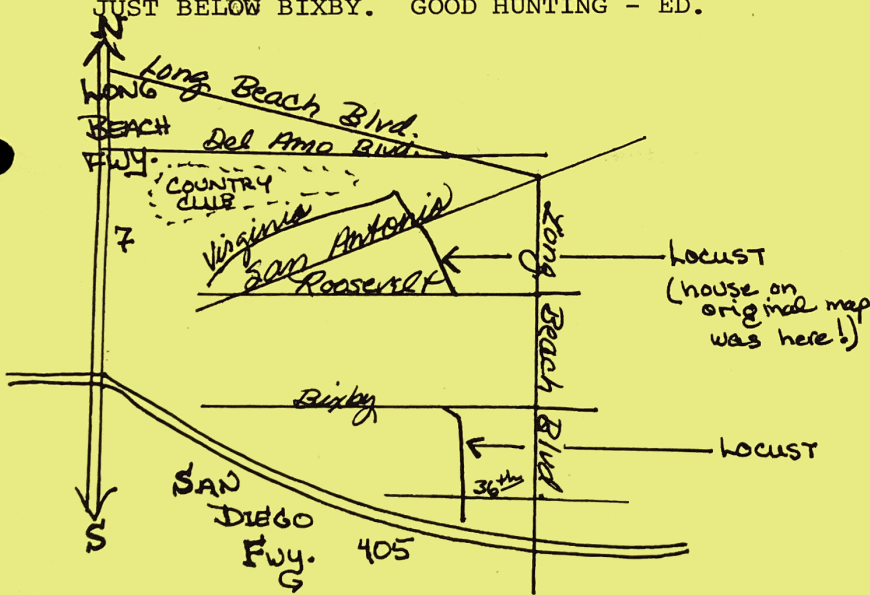
NOVICE NEWS

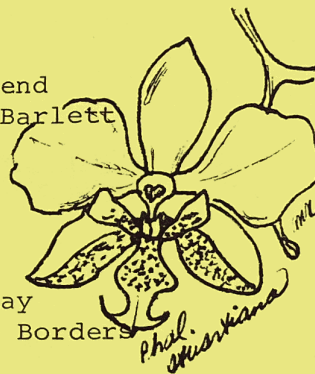

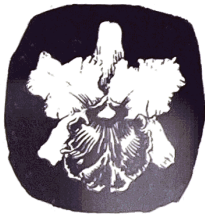
