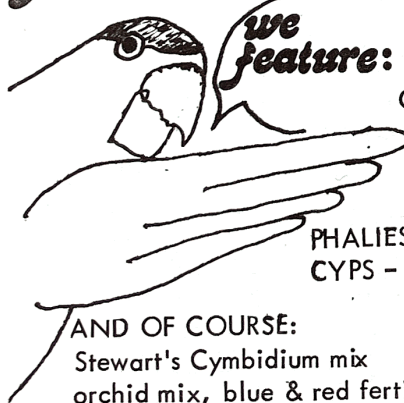

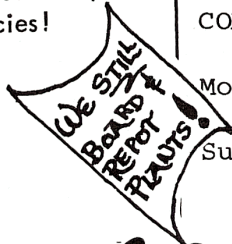

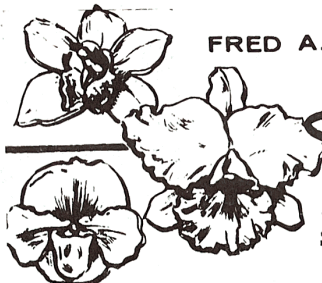

Bring a chair, a good plant for the Plant Table (preferably a named orchid) and come from ten to twelve. Bring a guest, too!

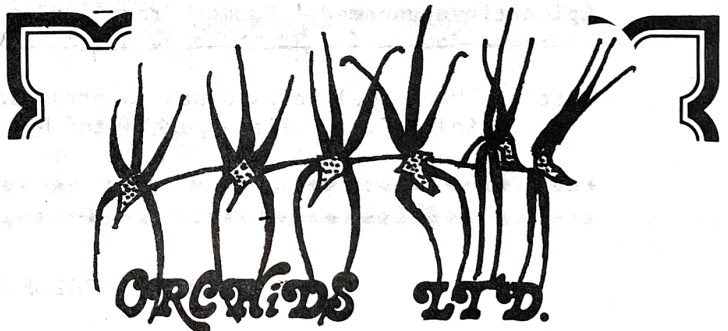
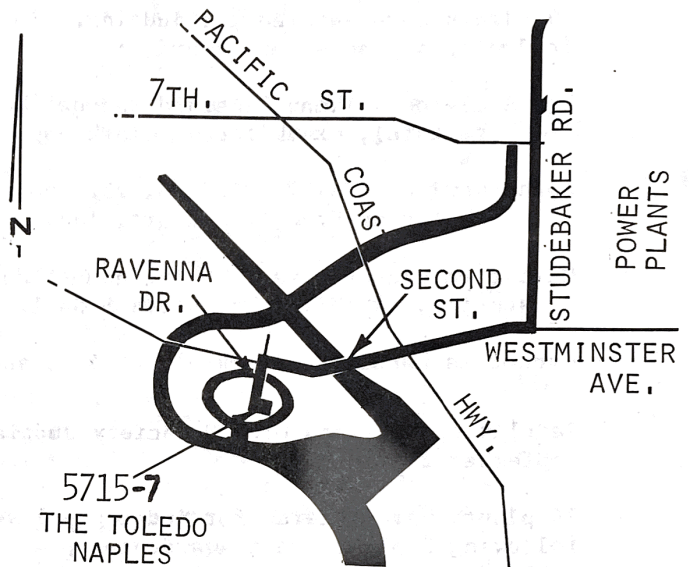

29 plants were entered for judging. 13 were screened, 12 scored low and the following 4 plants were awarded:

Lc. Adelaide Waltman 'Emerald Pagoda' HCC/AOS, 76.8 points, (Lc. Elstead Gem x C. guttata), exhibited by Clark Day, Jr. and P. G. Barnett.

Paph. Kowloon '73177' HCC/AOS, 75.8 points, (Paph. New Era x Paph. purpurata), exhibited by Fred A. Stewart, Inc.

Catesetum saccatum var. christyanum 'Adagen's Hummingbird' HCC/AOS, 76.1 points, species, exhibited by Curtis & Sally Gean.

Cycnoches maculatum 'Mackay' CBR/AOS, species, exhibited by Robert I. Mackay.

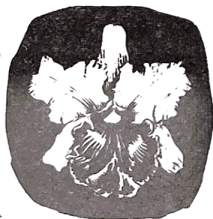
