### "THE INTERGENERIC ODONTOGLOSSUM HYBRIDS"

Howard Liebman, M.D.

Dr. Liebman is Professor of Hematology and Oncology at U.S.C.

He is specializing with his orchids in *Odontoglossums* and *Miltonias*. Several of his articles have been published in the *American Orchid Society Bulletin*, the latest of which appears in the April issue.

# NOVICE NEWS

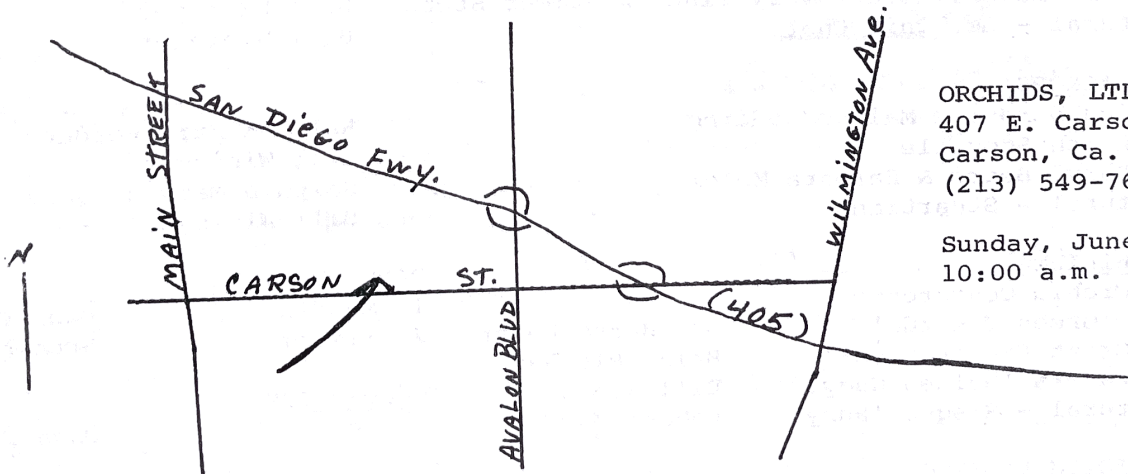
