Thanks to Myrtle for having us and giving us the chance to see her fabulous place and to Lloyd for coming and giving the program.

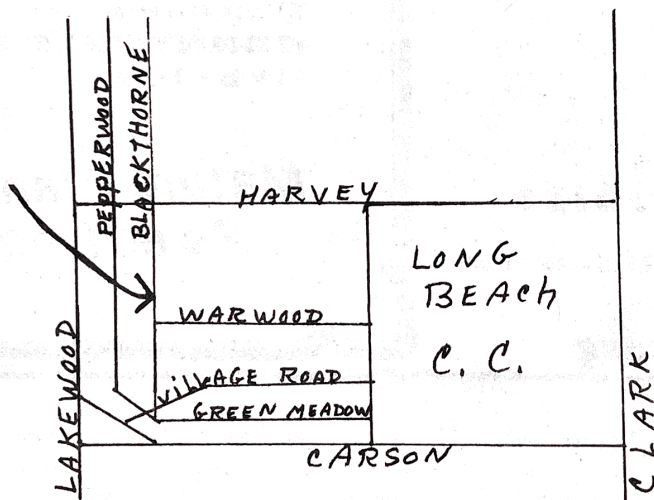
Also, we want to extend our best wishes to Sam Koenigsburg for a speedy recovery. Sam suffered a heart attack in February and is recuperating at home now.
