LAST MONTH

Some of the best known flower arrangers in Southern California had front row seats last month when Lynn Mauzer gave us so many tips on successful arranging. I knew he was noted for very exotic arrangements, specializing in orchids. However, I wasn't prepared for the use of commonplace material along with the orchids to make up his exotic specialties--old dried Agapanthus blossoms, dried Century plant blossoms, etc. Lynn made an important point in suggesting that flowers will last much better in new, clean tubes or vials instead of old ones which may contain bacteria, algae, etc. Also, he is a strong believer in a solution of 1 tablespoon of gin to a quart of water to harden the flowers. Any old cheap gin will do - it need not be Beefeaters.

==Novice News==

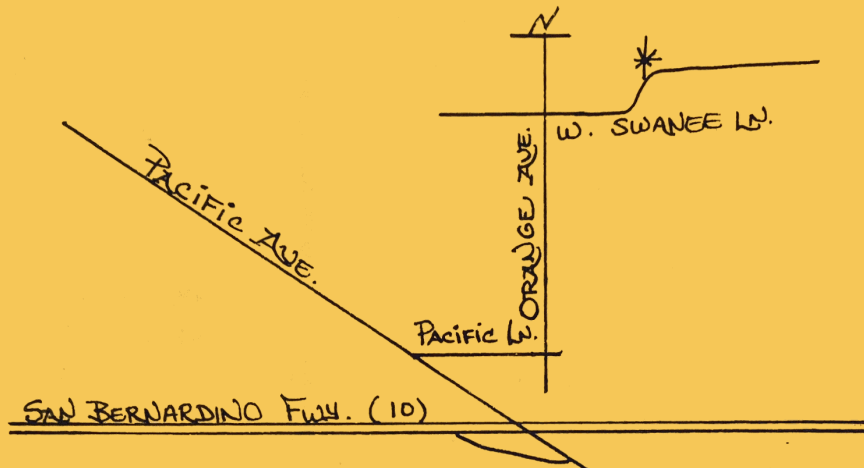
