Novice News

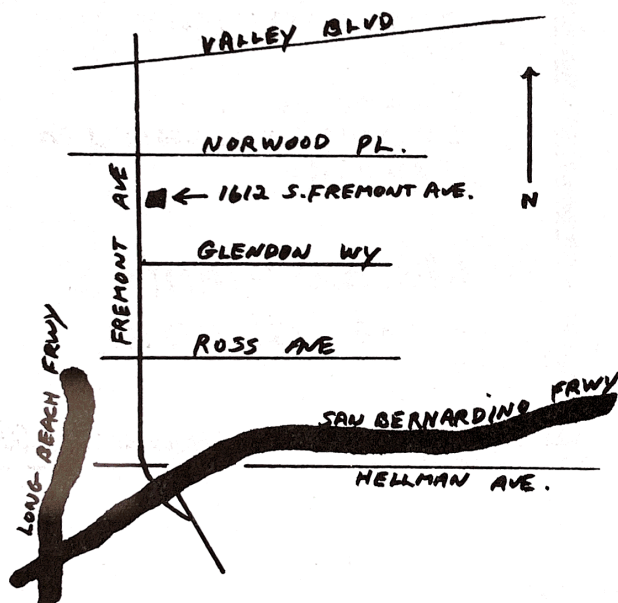

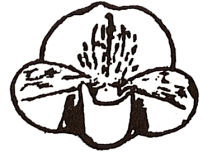

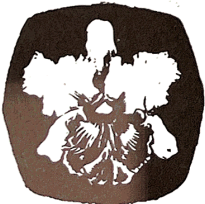
