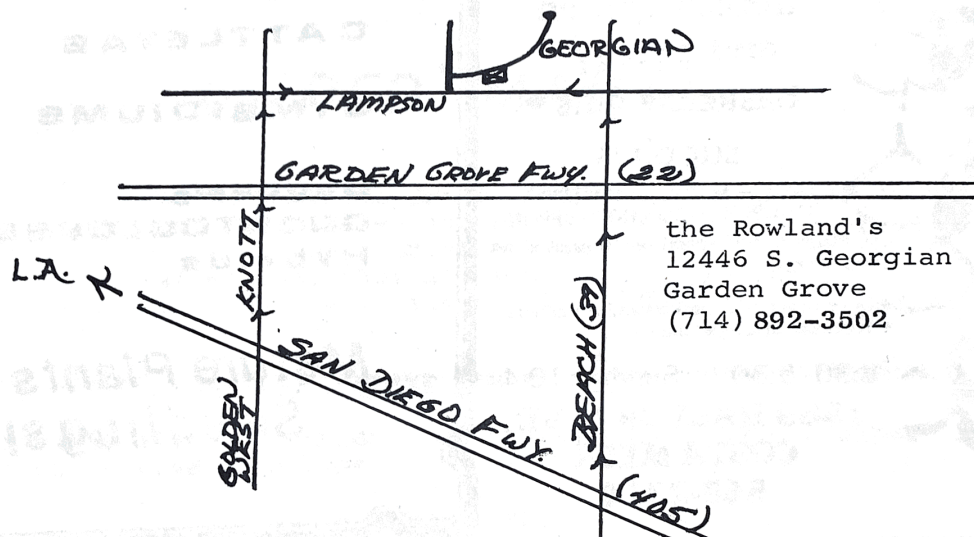
It was especially nice to welcome several new members and guests. All Society members and their guests and friends are invited to attend these meetings on the first Sunday of each month.

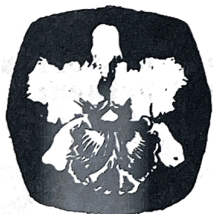
