-- Novice News --

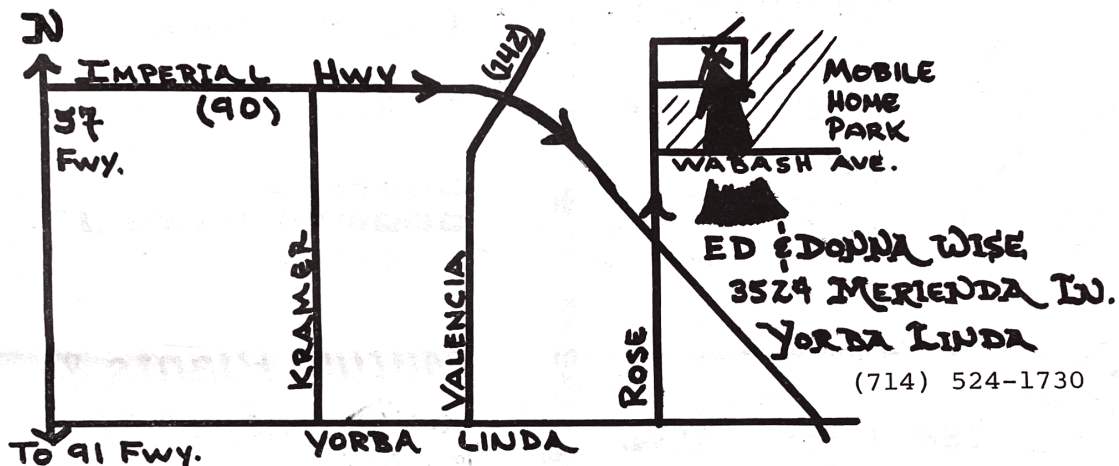
The April Novice meeting will be held at the home of Ed and Donna Wise, 3524 Merienda Lane, Yorba Linda.

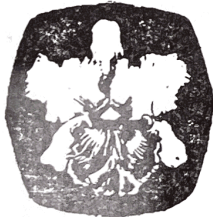
