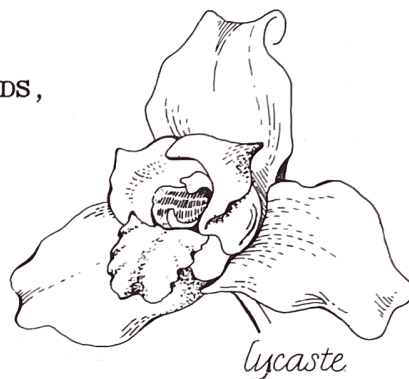

MODERN LYCASTE BREEDING

Wyld Court is a commercial firm founded in the 1930's by Sir William Cook. It is here that Lycaste breeding was really initiated and today the firm is, without doubt, the foremost Lycaste breeder in the world.

Terry has managed the firm for about eight years. Before that he spent some time here on the West Coast, working at Arthur Freed's, Santa Barbara Orchid Estate and in the Seattle area.



Wyld Court also specializes in Cymbidiums and they are probably the foremost dealer in England in unusual species, with emphasis on cool growing conditions.

With just one award in August and no Ribbon Judging, we take this opportunity to mention that the A.O.S. Registrar of Awards has brought to our attention the fact that many awards are pending awaiting completion of one or more of the following steps which must be undertaken by the exhibitor:

1. All flowers which earn a CBR or CHM must have the identification verified immediately after awarding by a competent taxonomist before the award will be finalized by the A.O.S. This identification is generally determined after the exhibitor sends a flower from the plant to the Marie Selby Botanical Gardens, then notifies the A.O.S. Registrar of Awards in Cambridge that the identification is verified.
2. All unregistered hybrids must be registered immediately after being awarded.
3. The award fee must be paid within 30 days after the A.O.S. billing.

If any one of the above items applies to your award, it will not be finalized (published). Furthermore, once a flower has been judged and awarded, the exhibitor must comply with the above requirements regardless of whether or not the exhibitor is satisfied with the award.

We want to thank Paul Brecht for hosting the group in August. It was a very good meeting and Paul very generously donated several gift certificates to us.

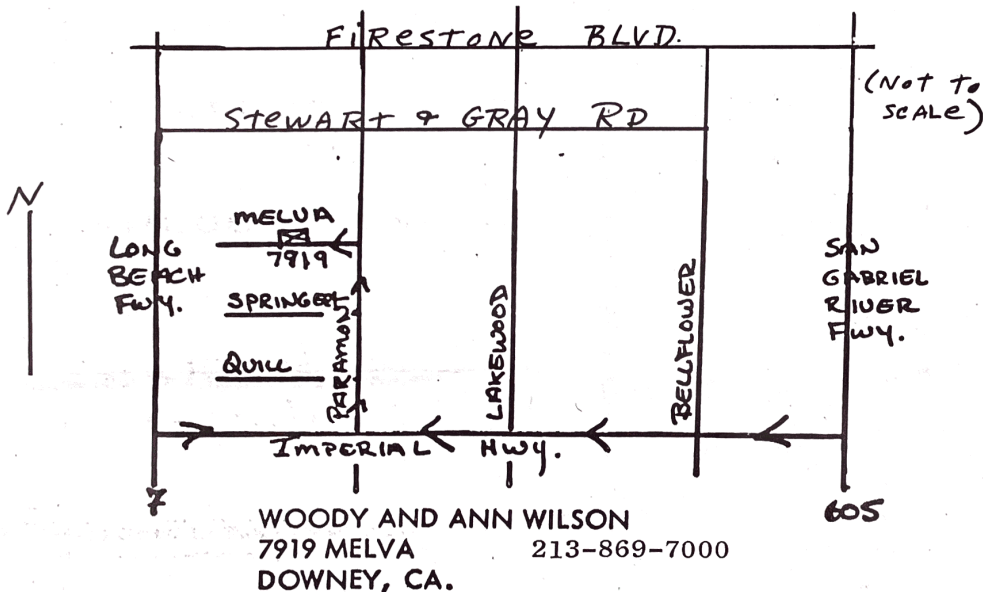
In September Don Pollard hosted another very successful meeting. The highlight was his demonstration on flower arranging - and donation of the piece to our opportunity table.

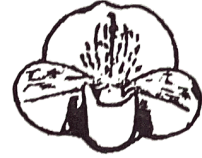

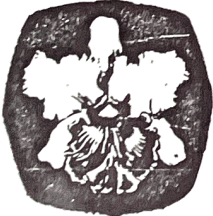
