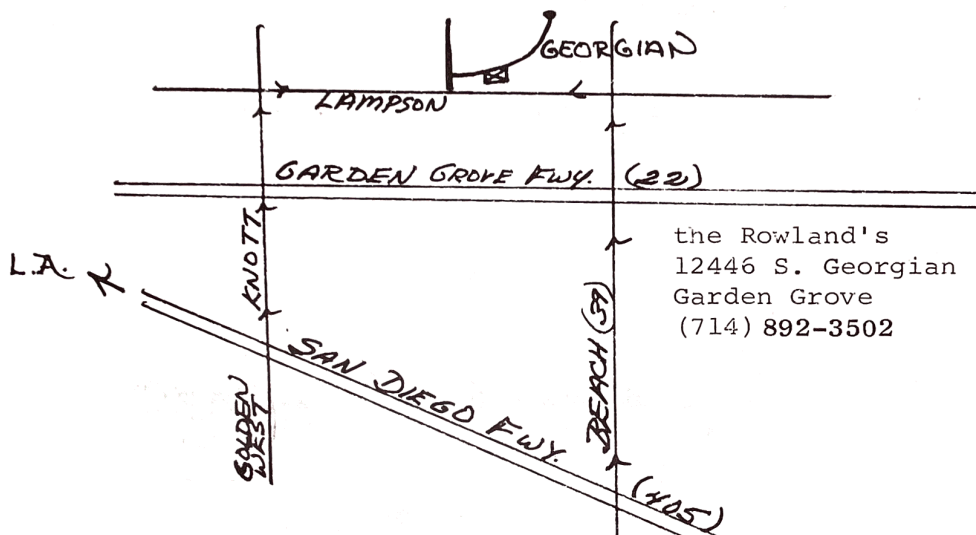
We wish to thank Woody and Ann Wilson for hosting the October meeting. We all had a great time, and it was an excellent meeting.

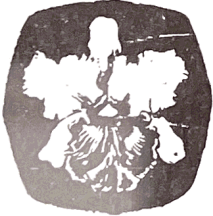
