RIBBON JUDGING

The purpose of ribbon judging is to encourage each and every member to bring in their blooming orchids so everyone can enjoy their beauty. This also gives exhibitors the chance to show off their finest plants. Exhibitors receive one raffle ticket for each plant shown. A trophy is awarded at the annual installation banquet for the exhibitor who has received the most points during the year. Points are awarded as follows: first (blue ribbon) 5 points, second (red ribbon) 3 points, third (white ribbon) 1 point, cultural (green ribbon) for a well grown plant with a good flower display 5 points.

Ribbon judging is performed by members of the society, of which three are required for each meeting. This is an opportunity for everyone to contribute to the meeting by volunteering to be a ribbon judge. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE A QUALIFIED JUDGE TO DO THIS. All this means is for the ribbon judge to pick the plants and flowers that appeal to you as an individual.

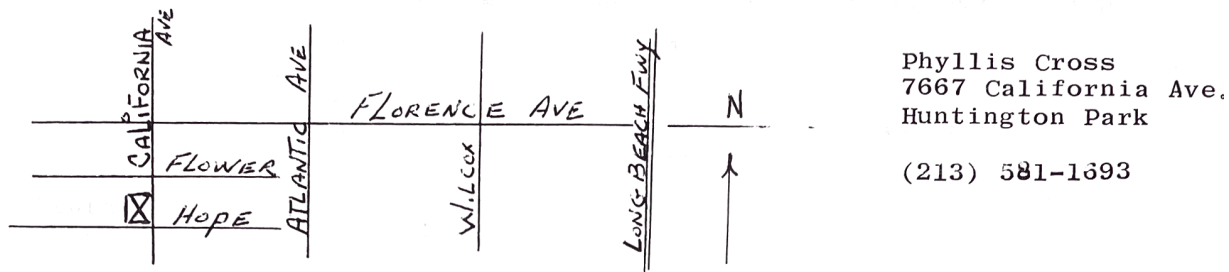

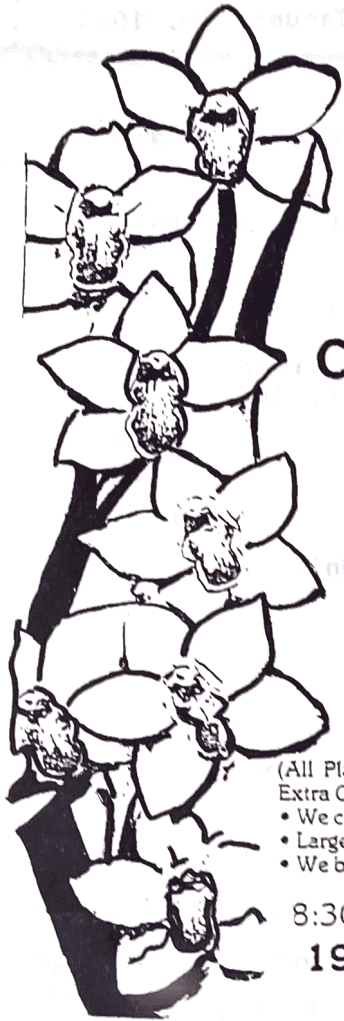

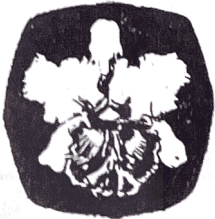
