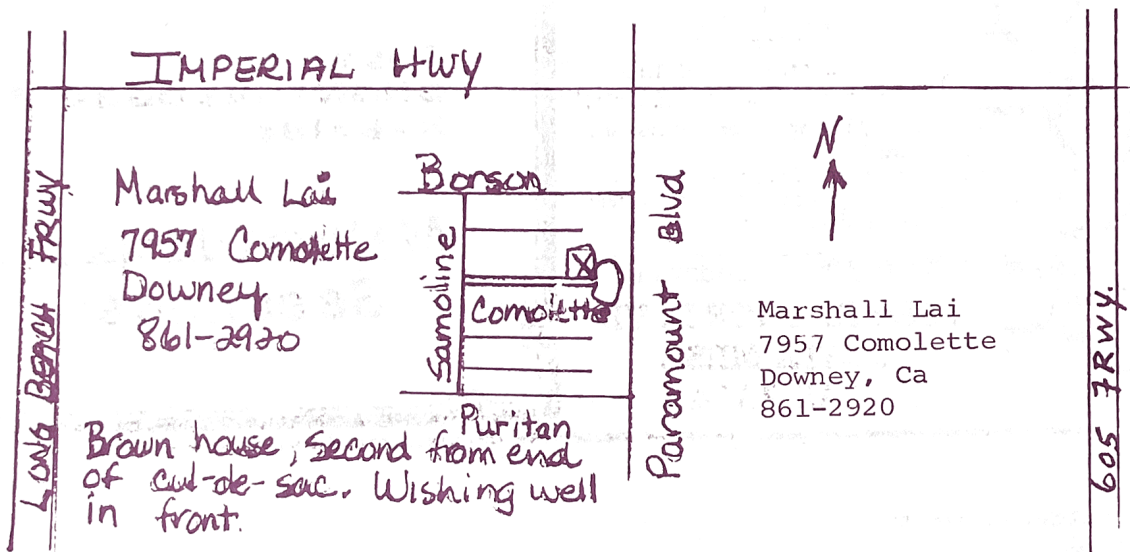
-- Novice News --

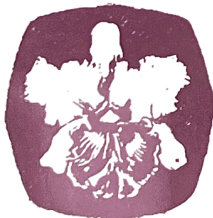
