#### ORCHIDS IN SOUTH AFRICA

We are highly honored this month to have as guest speaker Dr. Jan George Boyazoglu of South Africa. He is presently Agricultural Counsellor to the United States and Canada and is attached to the South African Embassy.

Dr. Boyazoglu is an animal scientist, economist, agricultural expert and Diplomate. He has been guest lecturer around the world and is an Honorary Professor at the University of Stellenbosch and is a member of the South African Academy of Science & Art and the International Wine Academy, Switzerland. He is also an Associate Professor with the Faculty of Agriculture at the Aristotelian University of Greece. He acts on a personal capacity as advising expert in agricultural research and development and animal production in the Mediterranean Basin, Africa, the Near and Far East.

He has received honors from the countries of France and Belgium, among others.

It is a distinct honor to have Dr. Boyazoglu speak at our February meeting. We feel sure you will want to hear him and to meet him.
