-- Novice News --

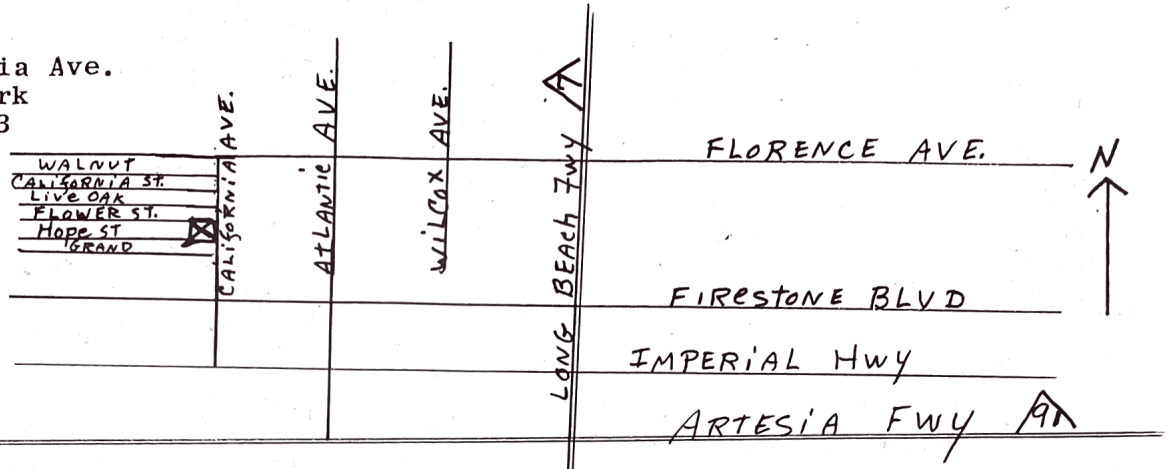
