DENDROBIUM NOBILE

OUTDOOR GROWING ORCHIDS - BY DR. ALLEN ISERI

Dr. Iseri is a young physician (pediatrics) who has made a study of the very colorful and showy Dendrobium Nobile. He has discovered a few simple, basic secrets which he will share with us. If we follow his instructions, we can all have a cascade of color (yellow, lavender, white, etc.) in our patios or hanging from the eaves each spring. Some varieties even bloom again in the fall.

Dr. Iseri and his wife, Dr. Kathleen Iseri, also grow many cymbidiums and they are both Judges for Cymbidium Society of America, Inc.

We feel sure you'll want to grow some Dendrobium Nobile plants out of doors after you hear Dr. Iseri's talk. You will have a profusion of color and they multiply quickly, which is another plus feature.

VIRUS: THE GOOD AND BAD NEWS (Excerpt from publication of Orchis Tissue Culture Laboratory - Santa Fe, New Mexico)

"It is possible (after the initial purge) to keep a healthy collection if you follow several rules for good culture that were offered by the late Dr. Walter Bertsch at a symposium in the New York Botanical Gardens.

- (1) Don't grow orchids in beds. Use pots. Virus spreads root to root.
- (2) Never use a cutting blade twice. Although some sterilizing procedures work, they are tedious and therefore rarely used properly. Buy disposable razor blades and use them. Don't pinch off old flowers by hand.
- (3) Never re-use pots, hangers, etc. unless you scrub them well then heat them to 400 degrees and let them cook for two hours. (Remember they must be heated to 400 degrees before the two hour timing starts). You can also pressure cook implements at 15-20 lbs. for 20 minutes.
- (4) Never buy a suspect plant. Test all new plants for virus before adding them to your collection. There are two exceptions to this rule. Orchids collected directly from the jungles have never been found to contain virus and test-tube babies are not usually infected since virus cannot penetrate the ovary to contaminate seeds and it is uncommon to mericlone virused plants.
- (5) Keep the insect population in your greenhouse down."

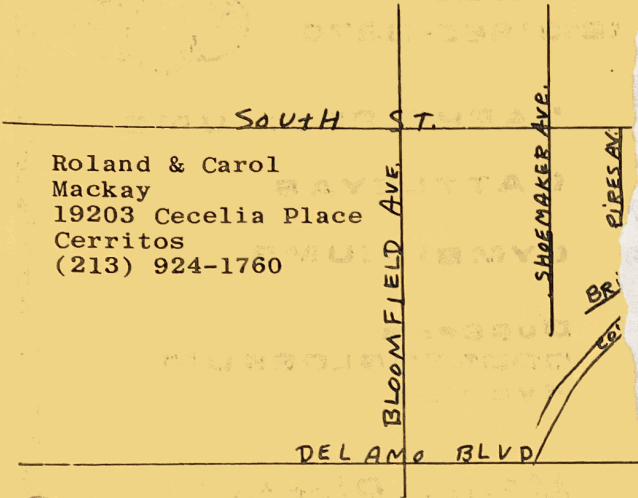
