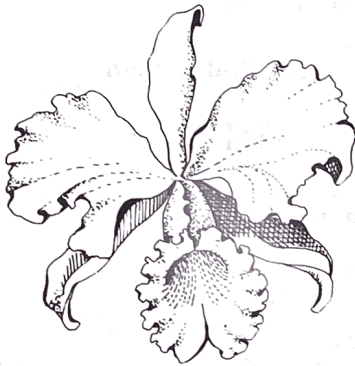

NOVICE NEWS

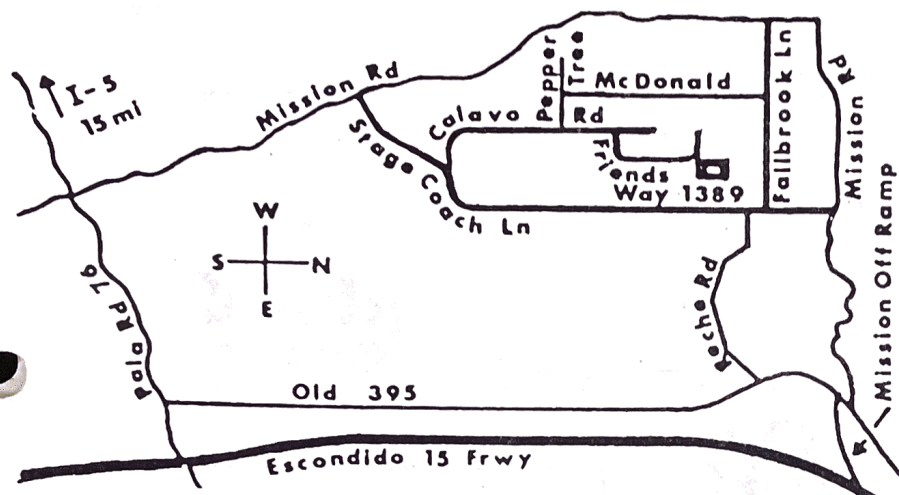
