WESTPORT CRANBERRY RELISH

- 3 cups fresh, whole cranberries
- 1 orange, unpeeled, quartered and seeded
- 1 tart apple, unpeeled, cored and quartered
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/4 t. cinnamon
- 1/8 t. salt
- 1/2 cup golden seedless raisins
- 1/2 cup chopped dried apricots
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans

Coarsely grind first three ingredients. Stir in sugar, salt, and cinnamon; set aside. Cook raisins and apricots in 1/2 cup water over medium heat until raisins are plump, about 5-10 minutes; drain. Stir raisins, apricots, and pecans into relish. Refrigerate overnight to allow flavors to blend. Yields approximately 3-1/2 cups.

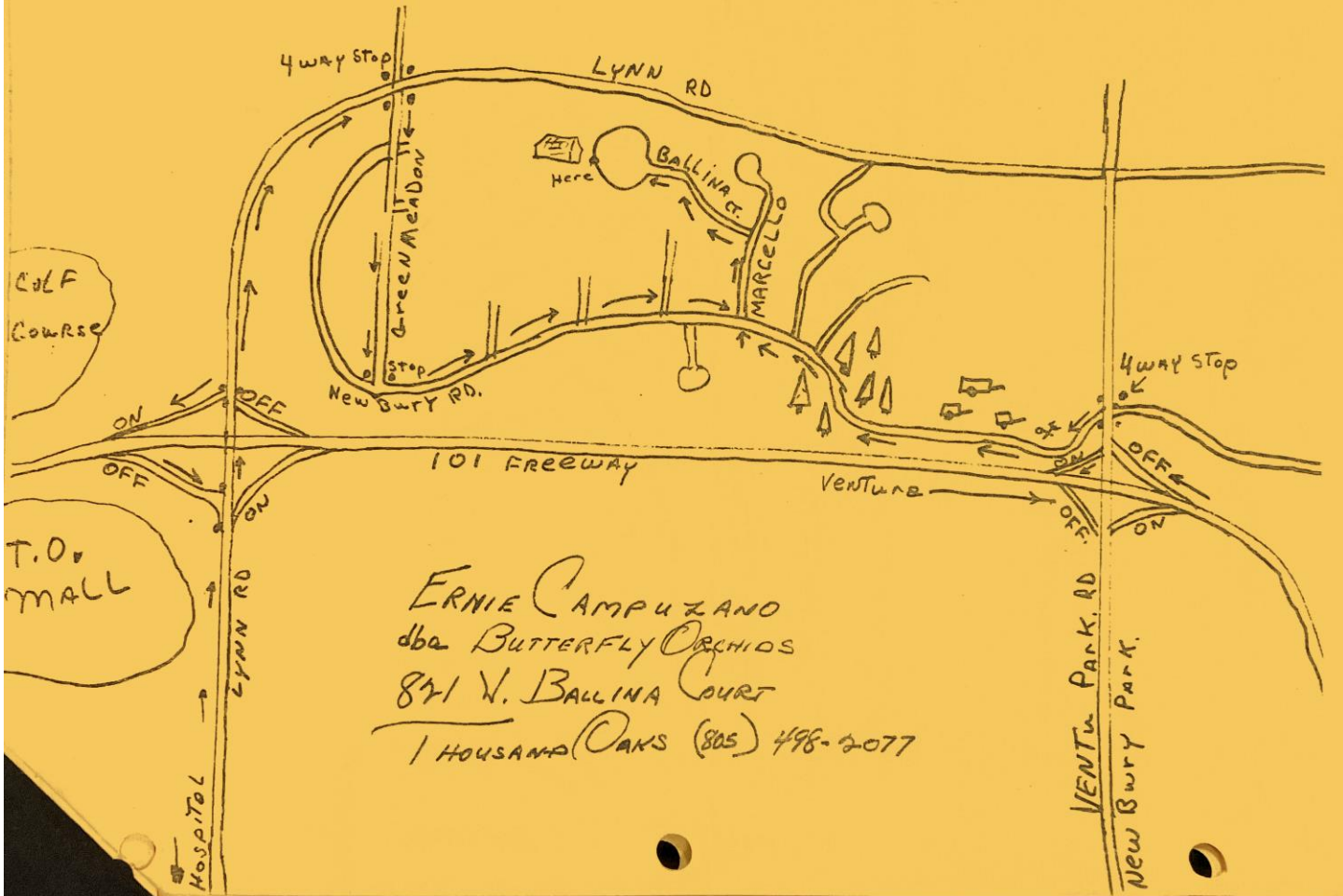
We are appealing to the members of the society for a 2nd Vice President. If you know of a member that will serve as the VP, please notify one of the officers or directors.
