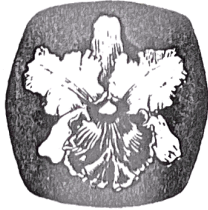

Please fill out the enclosed card so that we have a table reserved for you.

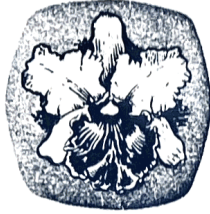
We at South Coast want to thank you for your continued support and assistance to our Society. See you October 27, 1986. Please find a map enclosed to Whaley Park Community Center.

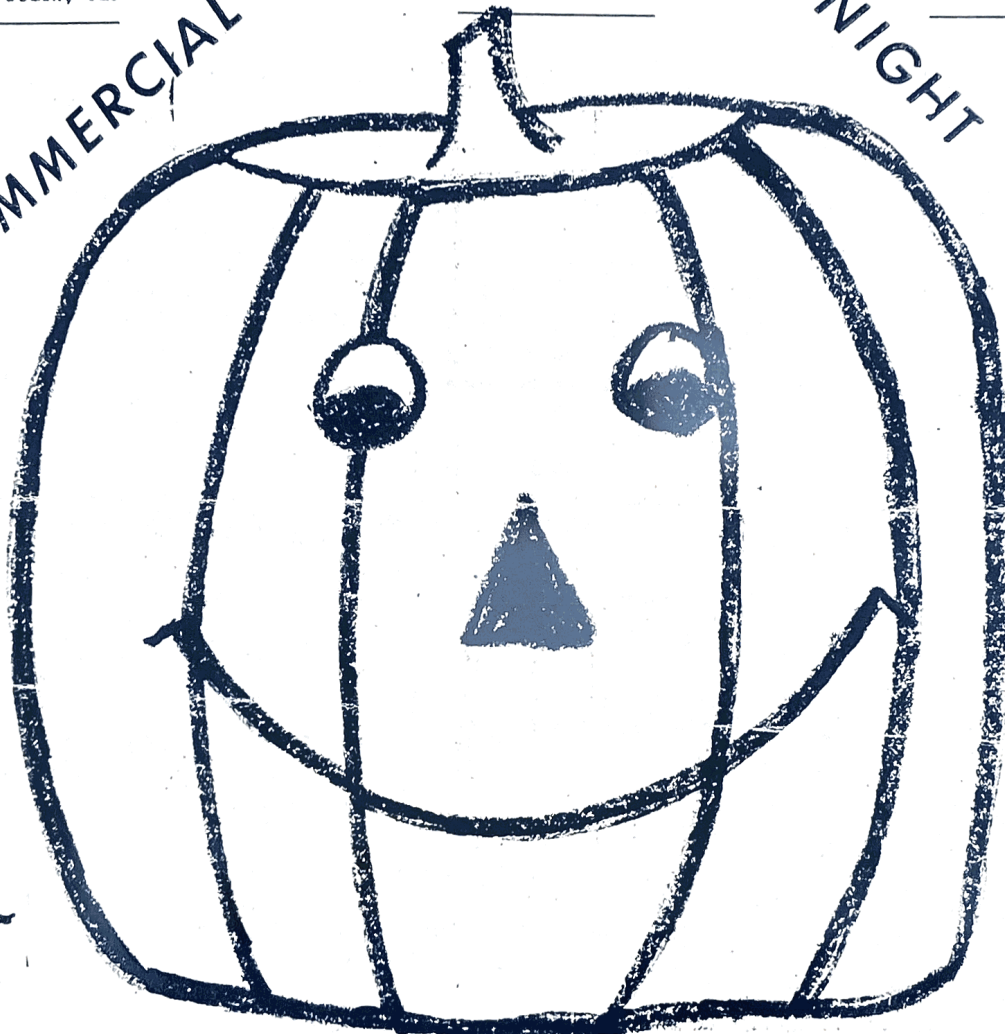

BY LAW CHANGE

At a Special Meeting of the Board of Directors the following resolution was presented:

WHEREAS: The agenda to be covered at the Board of Director Meetings six times a year is not necessary and the difficulties of obtaining a quorum at six meetings

THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED: That the By-Laws be changed as to read:

Regular meeting of the Executive Board shall be held every ninety (90) days at such time and place as may be specified by a majority of Board Members upon at least two weeks written notice by the President to each member of the Board. Any meetings of the Board may, for lack of quorum or other cause, be adjourned to some definite place and time, not exceeding thirty (30) days thereafter; if, for any cause, any regular meeting of the Board shall not be called or held, a meeting in lieu thereof may be called at any time and place by a majority of the Board members upon at least two week written notice. At meetings of the Board a quorum shall consist of seven (7) members of the Executive Board.

The Board of Directors adopted this resolution.

The resolution will be voted on at the regular monthly meeting by the members present on November, 1986.

DID YOU KNOW?

When was the first award given to an orchid by the American Orchid Society and what was the name of the plant?

The awards were first made in 1932 at a meeting of the Board of Trustees in Philadelphia on April 29, 1932. A gold medal was given to Edward H. Lincoln of Pittsfield, Mass., in recognition of outstanding work in photographing native orchids. An Award of Merit (A.M.) was given to Cattleya Schroderae var. Hercules, exhibited by F. E. Dixon, Elkins Park, Pas., and also, a similar award to Bc. Springtime, Stonehurst var., exhibited by Orchidwood, Inc., New Rochelle, N.Y. The first F.C.C. was given on October 5, 1932 at a Board of Trustees meeting in Philadelphia, to Cattleya Moira var, The Bride. This was exhibited by F. E. Dixon.

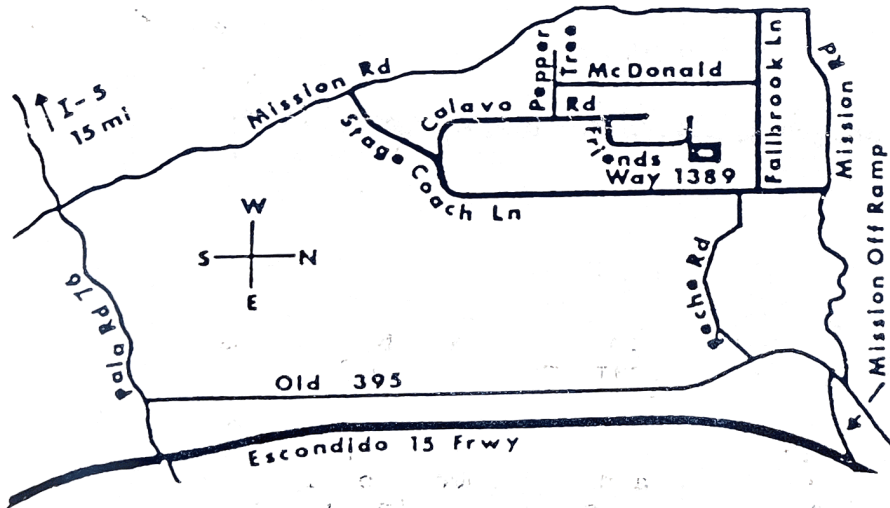

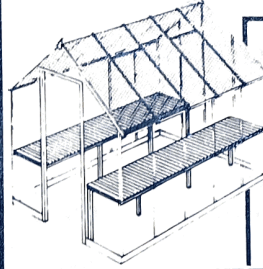

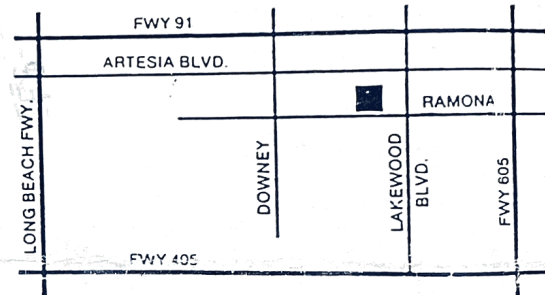
