

### POTTING

It has been often said that more growers come to grief with improper potting than with any other aspect of growing, for if a cattleya is improperly potted, the chances of its ever being able to grow well are almost nil, regardless of the care it is given. Because of this need for drying, clay rather than plastic pots are favored by most growers.

Although there is no definite rule regarding the time of year when cattleyas can be potted, the winter months are generally considered the least desirable. Rather, the warmer months, when the days are longer, sunshine is increased, and there are

more favorable growing conditions to help the plant become reestablished, are to be preferred.

Although some roots appear on the top of the potting material, the majority, and by far the most important for the development of the plant, grow below the surface of the potting material and are attached to the sides and bottom of the pot. However, if the cattleya seems determined to grow horizontally instead of up straight, this situation can be corrected by gently tying the growth to a stake firmly set into the potting material. Then gradually it can be straightened up as it grows, but care must be taken to prevent breaking off the new growth.


