## "Triple Header" Program

**GEORGE HARR** - who is an inveterate hiker. Last year he took a trip to Nepal to go on a trek to Mt. Annapurna. It was a 15-day trip and he says that through the foothills at 3,000 to 6,000 ft. elevations it was just solid orchids. He will share some of his pictures of the orchids as they grow plus some taken at orchid gardens in Katmandu, Nepal and orchid farms in Bangkok.



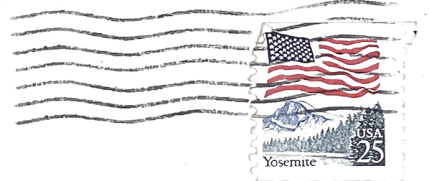

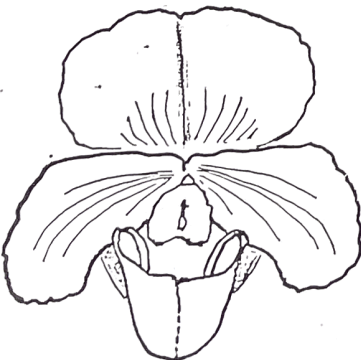
