Special holiday refreshments will be provided by our OFFICERS and DIRECTORS. You will remember from other years the delicious treats at Christmastime.


So -- come a week early - enjoy a display of beautiful orchids - maybe win a plant in bloom for yourself for Christmas - and sample some delicious holiday treats.






