## Reflections On Last Meeting



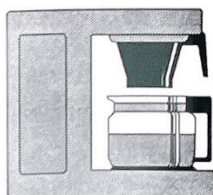

### WINE CAKE

1 - Yellow Cake Mix	1 - 4 1/2 oz. Package Vanilla Instant Pudding
4 - Eggs	2/3 - Cup Wesson Oil
1 - Cup Cream Sherry	1 tsp - Nutmeg

Combine all. Mix for Five Minutes. Pour into a greased bundt Cake pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until golden brown. Cool. Turn out. Sprinkle with powdered sugar.

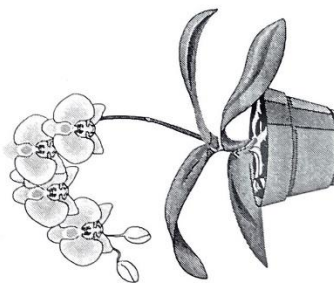
