Culture for Chinese Cymbidiums

Light: ensifolium type - 70% shade cloth. sinese and goeringii types - two layers of shade cloth, 70% and 50%.

Temperature: 40 F to 100F.

Water: Chinese Cymbidium: need more water than other types. Water every day in the hot summer and when the plant is dry in the winter.

Fertilizer: Use any balanced (20-20-20) brand of fertilizer. Maisie also uses Superthrive with the fertilizer. Use half the strength recommended and apply every 1 to 2 weeks. Never fertilize when plants are in flower.

Growing Media: The medium should remain moist but be fast-draining to prevent root rot from soggy stale media.

Maisie uses small & medium fir bark, perlite and redwood compost mixed together with a little charcoal. They also use some sphagnum moss around the plant base.

Plants should be repotted every year and can be done at any non flowering time.

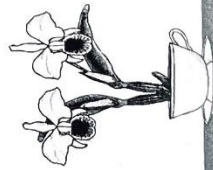
