Pest Control

A continuation of some pest control ideas adapted from a pamphlet produced by Miskimens Orchids.

SCALE: There are several types of scale which infest all Orchid genera with the Soft Brown Scale as the most common. All species of scale have a ten day life cycle so any contact spray must be applied at ten day intervals for three applications in order to be effective. The same insecticides which are used for mealybugs (i.e. sevin, malathion, rubbing alcohol) are effective for scale.

MITES: There are several types of mites which infest Orchids. They are most commonly found on Phalaenopsis, Dendrobiums, Cymbidiums and other thin leafed Orchids. Incidentally, Cyclamen plants are one of the most common carrier of mites. Therefore, don't keep Cyclamen plants close to your Orchids. A commonly used control for mites is the kelthane. This chemical is not sold by itself but is an ingredient of many sprays on the market such as Venden & Orthomite.
