### South Coast Orchid Society Then and Now

Jim Miller and his friend, Jack Gentry were introduced to orchids through Paul Baker who was the first president of the South Coast Orchid Society. At one time they had three greenhouses in Long Beach and grew about 4,000 plants. Today Jim lives in Quail Valley which is near Sun City and Lake Elsinore. The climate there is just too hot for outdoor growing and he does not have a greenhouse.

Jack Gentry is presently living on the Westside of Los Angeles in order to be near the U.C.L.A. Medical Center. Jack is a C.P.A. and Jim's degree is J.D. They were together in an accounting business for many years.

The California College of Commerce, which opened in 1921, was a private school and the first college established in Long Beach. Jim and Jack took it over in the 1970's and tried to bring it back into good condition. At that time there were many immigrants who came to Long Beach from Cambodia, Thailand and China who were attracted to the college. Jim even made a trip to China where he recruited quite a few students. When the other schools in the area offered free tuition for these students using Federal money, the Calif. College of Commerce could not compete.

Jim's next venture was to become a Certified Nurse and he worked in acute care. He has recently had carpal tunnel surgery on each wrist. Although he is unable to work as a nurse, he continues to help with the well-being of patients by volunteering as a Certified Ombudsman under the Department of Social Services and the Department of Health and has responsibility as an Ombudsman for ten skilled-nursing and board and care facilities.

Jim doesn't remember how many years he has served South Coast Orchid Society as Treasurer. When he was at the college on Pine Avenue in Long Beach the trip to meetings was short and many of the Board of Directors meetings were held right there. Now he travels approximately 120 miles round trip to each meeting and each Director's meeting, always coming prepared with comprehensive financial reports for the officers and directors. He is definitely devoted to the South Coast Orchid Society!




only for his support, but also for going that extra mile to make all things work out smoothly. You're sensational, Art, a million thanks from all of us.






