

Culture Note: Even though it is Winter, with temperatures cooler and daylight reduced, your orchids still need occasional watering. Water when the daytime temperature is nearing its peak, to give the orchids time to dry before nightfall and avoid the threat of bacterial rot. Also, though not a great repotting season for most orchids, if you have an orchid that is not doing well, one that has been in the same bark so long that the bark has become toxic to the plant, repot it; put it in fresh bark and keep it watered to avoid drying out until new roots develop.
